Llesiant

yn ystod y cyfnod hwn, rydym hefyd am gefnogi llesiant ac iechyd meddwl disgyblion felly byddant yn medru cyrchu gwasanaeth wythnosol, ailgydio gyda thiwtor dosbarth ac adnoddau llesiant eraill (gweler y wefan am fanylion).

Bydd Tiwtoriaid Dosbarth yn cynnal sesiynau Ailgydio/Llesiant yn ystod sesiwn gofrestru Dydd Mawrth a Dydd Gwener rhwng 09.30 a 10.00. Os oes gan ddisgyblion unrhyw bryderon am unrhyw agwedd o ddisgyblion neu faterion ynglŷn â'u llesiant, dylent gysylltu â'r Athro Dosbarth fydd yn sicrhau y cyfeirir eu pryderon at yr aelod staff mwyaf priodol.

On-line learning until January 18th

From Thursday 7th January, we will provide full-time remote education to all other students. Wherever possible, all lessons will be delivered live. All sessions will be recorded to safeguard pupils and staff. This will also allow pupils to access lessons that they miss or revisit sessions to review the work covered.

Students will be able to access lessons through their Microsoft Teams accounts. Full details are on the school website – <https://brodinefwr.org.uk/>

All pupils must behave in a respectful manner when they are accessing their on-line lessons. They must listen to and take direction from their teacher when in class.

If a child demonstrates behaviour that the teacher deems to be unacceptable or inappropriate the teacher will follow the school behaviour systems, with warnings being given, contacting parents if necessary, and logging incidents on SIMS.

Lesson Timing

Many students struggle with maintaining the same level of focus on-line as they have when they are in a classroom as it's easier to get side-tracked at home. Because it's difficult enough to concentrate for a long time, the timing of lessons will be as follows:

09.30 – 10.00 Registration
10.00 – 10.45 Lesson 1
10.45 – 11.00 Break
11.00 – 11.45 Lesson 2
11.45 – 12.30 Lesson 3
12.30 – 13.30 Lunch
13.30 – 14.15 Lesson 4
14.15 – 15.00 Lesson 5

Please can I respectfully remind you that in many cases, teachers will also be supporting their own children at home during this period and pupils should only contact staff during their timetabled lessons.

Wellbeing

During this time, we also want to support pupils' wellbeing and mental health so they will be able to access a weekly assembly, form tutor check-in and other wellbeing resources (see website for details).

Form Tutors will be holding Check-in/Wellbeing sessions during the Tuesday and Friday Registration session between 09.30 and 10.00. If pupils have concerns regarding any aspect of on-line learning or issues regarding their wellbeing, they should contact their Form Tutor who will ensure that their concerns are directed to the most appropriate member of staff.
